

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION:

Effective January 1, 2011, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Regular (Preferred) Classes:

- For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers 8 inches (4 inches)
- For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers 12 inches (8 inches)
- For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers 16 inches (12 inches)
- For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers 20 inches (16 inches)
- For dogs over 22 inches at the withers 24 inches (20 inches)

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE & MOTEL INFORMATION

This is MICHIGAN....Construction on many roads...please plan accordingly.

From I-94 (Heading West): Take the Zeeb Road exit and head North. You will cross the Huron River and then some RR tracks. At the stop sign turn left onto Huron River Drive. You will pass Dexter-Huron Metropark on your left (see map above). Approximately 1.5 miles down the road you will make a right turn onto the cross drive connecting us to Joy Road.

From I-94 (Heading East): Take the Baker Road exit and head North. Stay on Baker Rd. until it ends in downtown Dexter (see map above). Turn left onto Ann Arbor St. and take the immediate right onto Central St.. You have to go around 'Monument Park'. Stay on Central and cross the Huron River. There is a party store on the corner where Huron River Drive and Mast Road intersect. You can either turn onto Huron River Drive and take the second driveway on the left (Dexter Research Center) or you can turn right onto Joy Rd and go approximately 1/4 mile until you see a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts".

From US-23 (Heading South): Take the North Territorial Road exit and head West. Go approximately 5.5 miles West until you come to a 4-way stop. Turn left onto Mast road and go 3miles until you come to Joy Rd. (speed limit will drop to 25 here). The Dexter party store is on the left. You can either go past the party store, turn onto Huron River Drive and take the second driveway on the left (Dexter Research Center) or you can turn before the party store, onto Joy Rd., and go approximately 1/4 mile until you see a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts".

From US-23 (Heading North): Take M-14 West towards Ann Arbor. Take the "Miller Road" exit. At the end of the exit ramp go across Maple Rd and you will come to Miller Rd. Turn right onto Miller and head West to Zeeb Rd (second stop sign). Turn right onto Zeeb and the first stop is Huron River Drive. Turn left onto Huron River Drive and approximately 1.5 miles down the road you will make a right turn onto the cross drive connecting us to Joy Road.

The building at the corner is the Dexter Research Center. There is a also a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts". We are the large building up the drive.

RUNNING ORDER

Standard classes, Time 2 Beat; JWW Classes

Small to tall: Ex. Classes Walk then Run 4, 8, 12, 16, Walk then run 20, 24, 26

First Received: All entries must be **RECEIVED** by the secretary prior to the closing date and be complete to be considered a valid entry. All duplicate entries for the same dog will be declared ineligible and the entry fees forfeited.

Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope.

Envelopes containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to sender.

No hand delivers in the first 24 hours following the trial opening date/time

Opening: August 8th at 8 A.M. Closing: October 7th at 6 P.M

Awards: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class, provided that they have earned qualifying scores.

Rosettes will also be awarded for new titles and MACH/PAX titles. Jump bars will be awarded to those completing a MACH/PAX titles.

Notice to Exhibitors

• **Entry fees: \$18 each entry**

- Telegraph, telephone, fax, and unsigned entries or entries without fees cannot be accepted.
- **Entries not on Official AKC Agility Entry without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry will NOT be accepted.**
- Express Mail Entries must include signature permitting them to be **left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature.**
- Returned or postdated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
There will be a \$30 service charge for each returned check.
- No hand delivers in the first 24 hours following the trial opening date/time
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms correctly and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.
- Irish Red and White Setter Association, Inc (IRWSA) may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against IRWSA, RuFF or any official thereof.
- IRWSA and RuFF will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the premises.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of judge or show committee.
- Bitches in season will not be admitted to the Trial. Entry fee (minus \$15) will be refunded for bitches in heat with a note from a veterinarian. Note must be received 24 hours before the start of judging.
- **Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. IRWSA assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.**
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.
- **Please clean up after your dog.** Receptacles will be provided.
- Overpayments of fees less than \$10 will be considered a donation to the club and will not be returned.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations

If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
